About the Clinic

The beauty and challenge of coaching is that it is ever-changing and requires work and effort to keep up with new techniques and methods to improve. If you have been here before, return and let us share the innovations that we have learned to help student-athletes succeed. Successful coaches are constantly trying to improve and develop their coaching skills. This clinic will touch on every aspect of coaching. It will increase your knowledge and present the "little things" that will take your team to the "next level."

This Clinic will help **beginning** coaches develop their style and skills in coaching and provide **advanced** coaches with the "little things" that will enhance their ability to further develop their coaching talents. Will discuss Coaching Philosophy and motivational techniques that work.

Topics Covered include:

Building Your Offense from A to Z: Will teach all aspects of Motion Offensive movement, from 1-1 to 5-5 play. Perimeter-Perimeter movement, Post-Perimeter Movement and Post to Post Movement. *Motion is the foundation of all offensive movement.*

Building Your Defense from A to Z: Will teach all aspects of defense including stance on ball, denial, helpside defense, post defense, team defense. *Learn how to build your team defense.*

Philosophy and Fundamentals: Will teach the "little things" that make great players and teams. Skills stressed will include Dribbling, Passing, Shooting, Rebounding. *Learn how to teach fundamentals.*

Zones - Attacking and Developing: Will stress zone defensive assignments in 3-2, 1-3-1, and 2-3 zones and how to attack zones. *Be prepared to make offensive and defensive adjustments throughout the game.*

Continuity Offenses: Will teach structured offensive movement, patterns of offensive play including the "Passing Game" and "Flex Offenses." *Have a pattern to rely on to control the ball in times of stress.*

Building A Practice Plan/Practice Drills: How to maximize your practice time and space. Drills that teach proper technique and fundamentals. Practice outlines that cover all skills necessary to succeed. *Have a short and long term plan for player and team development.*

Attacking Pressure: How to attack and use defensive pressure to improve your offense. *Pressure defense leads to easy layups with proper spacing and movement.*

Open Forum: You choose the topics, we will do the teaching. *Don't leave until all of your questions are answered.*
